INTERN APPLICATION & SELECTION PROCESS

The CTE Internship Program is a learning and working opportunity. Our interns receive rigorous theatrical training while functioning as salaried employees of the CTE staff. (Gross salary is approx. \$900-\$1100).

Interns train in child development, teaching methods, and all aspects of theatre. They apply their skills working during the CTE workshops as mentors and technicians.

Other responsibilities may include:

- **attending** briefing meetings
- **leading** daily circle groups and classes
- **role-modeling** the CTE philosophy

Interns must take part in training sessions before CTE begins.

Requirements for Intern Applicants

- Must be at least 14 years old (or at least 14 before the next summer begins) and have completed 8th grade
- Must be available for the entire length of CTE workshop dates with training beforehand (see attached schedule)
- Must have demonstrated ability to work unsupervised
- Leadership experience with children is preferred (may be drawn from past CTE experience)

Application Procedure

- Applications must be completed and returned to the Program Director no later than April 30th, 2023 (may be emailed to admin@ctekids.org)
- Selected applicants will interview with members of the selection committee in May

Note: Preference may be given to applicants with prior experience in CTE.
