WHAT IS CTE?

In operation since 1982, CTE is a unique summer theatre program for students in first through twelfth grade held at South Puget Sound Community College. Students attend for up to 4 hours a day, for 4, 5 or 6 weeks.

- CTE weaves education into the program. Unlike other youth theatre programs, our students receive classes in the different aspects of theatre arts.
- At CTE, the primary emphasis is on the process of creating the production. CTE values every role, onstage and off.
